- ***Community sponsored street event on E. Alegria Ave***
- ***SMECT was activated by the SM Police at 1730 hrs.***
- ***Goal***
 - ***Monitor street activity to have a safe event***
 - ***Hams performed street patrols and assisted with pedestrian traffic control at Baldwin and Mountain Trail Avenues street crossings***





SMECT - HALLOWEEN 2025



- ***Around 7,000 people***
- ***No major incidents***
- ***Incidents/found objects***
 - ***Helped a boy find his lost parents***
 - ***iPods found and turned over to police***
- ***Porta potties and trash receptacles were available***
- ***Weather – clear, 75° @ 1700 and ~65° @ 2200***
- ***CERT & Foothill Flyers Radio Club***
- ***Ham Radio Support ~53 person-hours on the street***
 - ***15 Ham Operators - from Sierra Madre with support from 7 other foothill communities & other cities***
 - ***Hams directed visitors to crosswalks @ Baldwin & Mountain Trail***
- ***Crowds started to dissipate around 2100***
- ***Police terminated the event around 2200 hours***

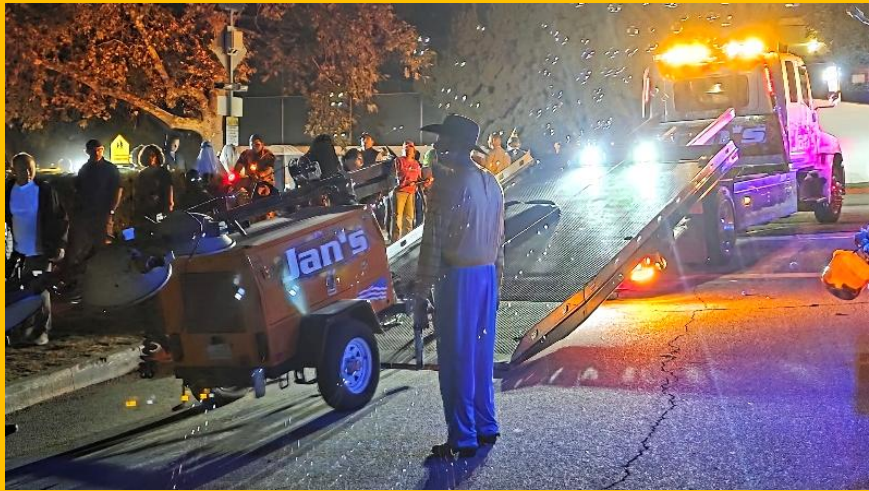

- **Lights (were late ~ 1930) but were placed perfectly**
 - **Baldwin** – On SE corner of Alegria & Baldwin facing W to the crosswalk
 - **Mountain Trail** – On Alegria near the NW corner facing SE to the crosswalk

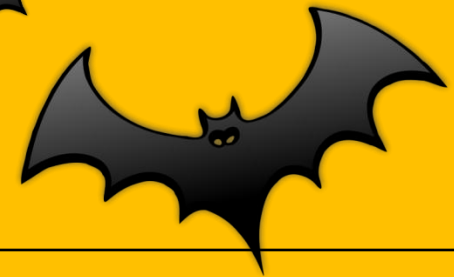


- **Porta-Potties**
 - **Baldwin** – good position on the parkway W and a little S of the crosswalk
 - **Mountain Trail** – poor position on the parkway on the E side of the S crosswalk
 - **Caused considerable congestion**
 - **Suggest placing it to the W of the light on the NW corner on Alegria**
 - **Needed an ADA porta-pottie**



- ***Only one officer and one police volunteer were available at Mountain Trail south side intersection***
 - *Hams were helping on the north side*
- ***Officer did not have reflective vest***
 - *One was loaned to him*
- ***Mountain Trail crosswalk***
 - *Need blinking lights to delineate crosswalk*
 - *Pedestrian crossing sign would be helpful*
 - *Additional barricades needed to block pedestrians from crossing on the north side*
 - *Additional delineators and caution tape needed*





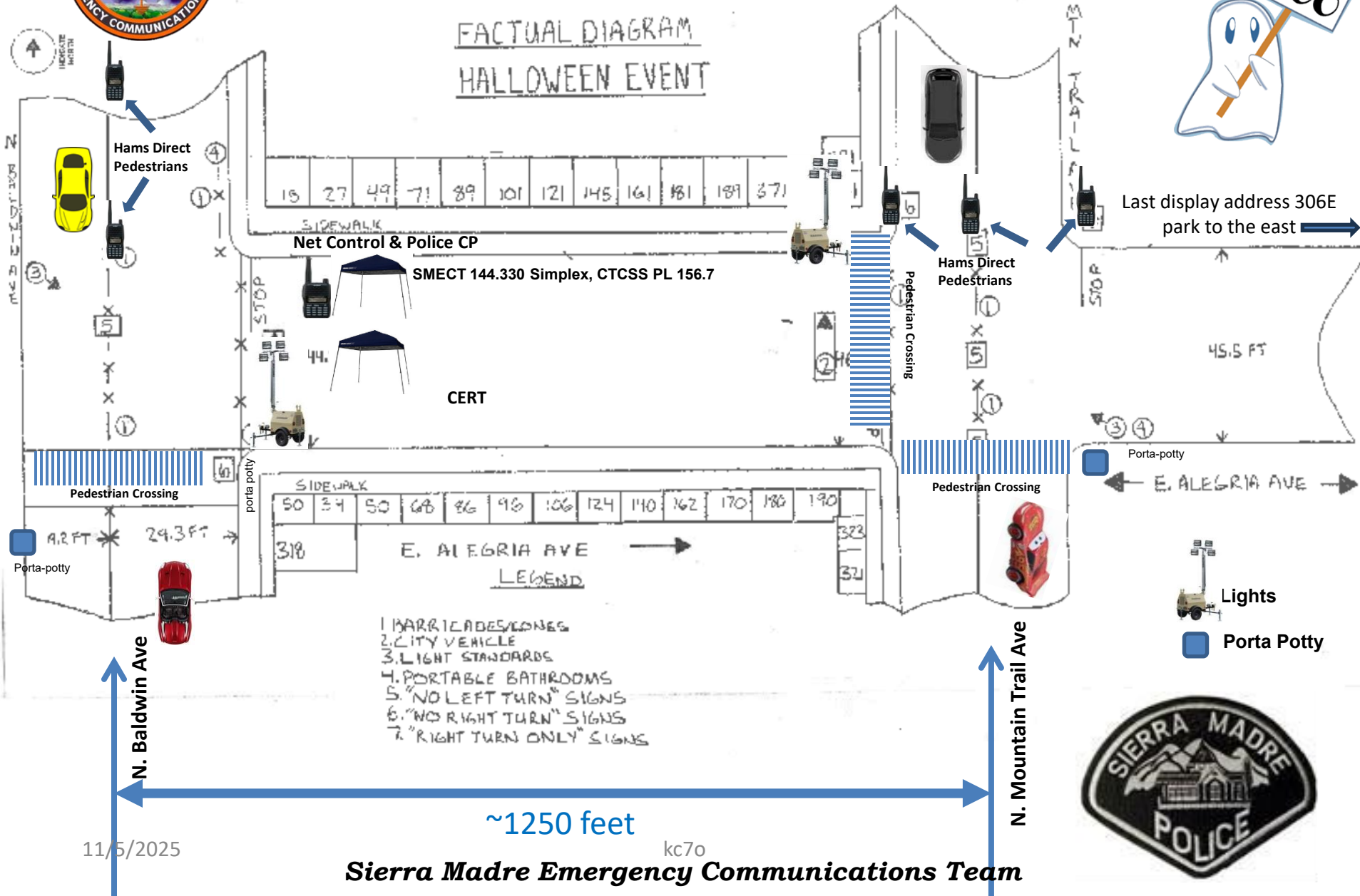

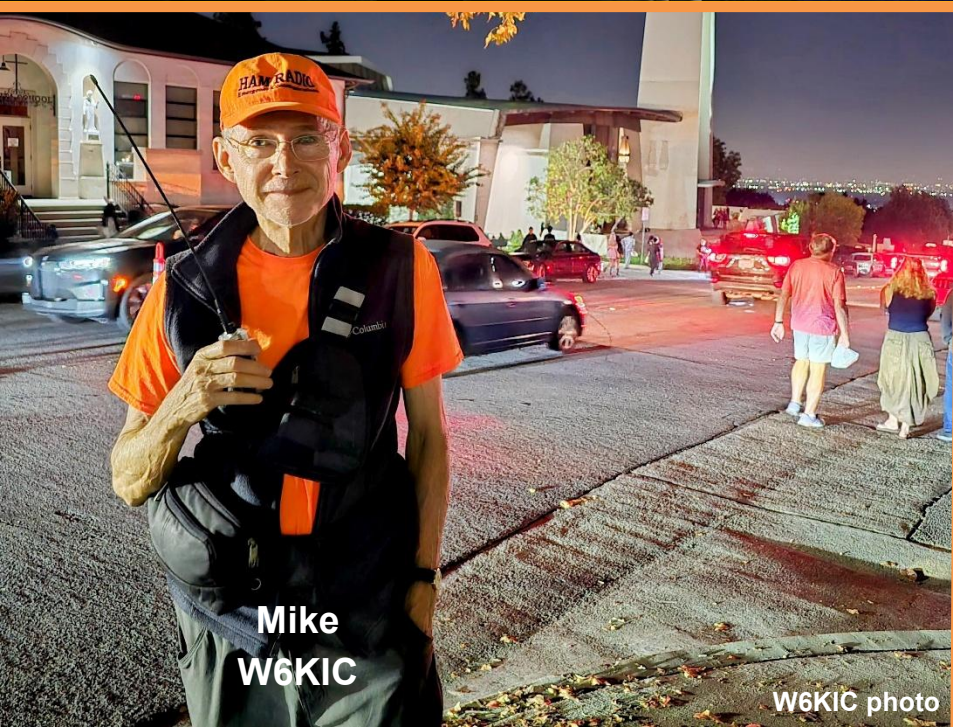

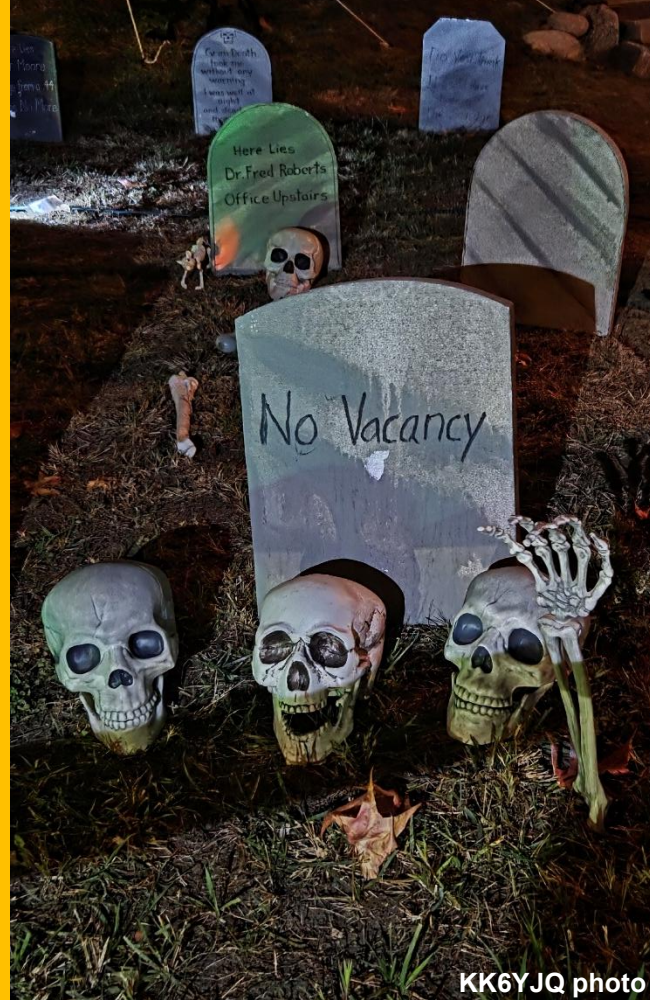
